90 Day Medication for Maintenance Drugs

Squaxin Island Health Clinic New Procedures for maintenance medication.

If you are on maintenance medication that are taken regularly for chronic conditions

You may be able to get a 90-day supply. Some examples are medications for diabetes or hypertension (High blood pressure) or High cholesterol.

Some medications will stay short term. Your provider will determine if your medication is eligible for a 90-day supply. Be aware most class II drugs or drugs that are in the controlled substance class are usually on the short-term list and are not eligible for a 90-day supply.

How to make the request for a 90-day supply of Maintenance Medication

- 1. If you receive, your maintenance medications from **Kamilche Pharmacy** please call and leave a message with the pharmacy 360-432-3990, the pharmacist will then send that request to the doctor.
- 2. If you see a doctor that does not work at the Squaxin Health Clinic, you will need to contact your doctor to see if you are eligible to receive a 90-day supply for your maintenance medications.
- 3. The doctor is the one that will make the determination if your maintenance medication can be prescribed a for 90 day period.
- 4. Remember, this procedure is a change at the Squaxin Island Health Clinic/Kamilche pharmacy services, so please allow a few days for this change.
- 5. **Do not** let your medications run out prior to calling in for a refill. This can mean a delay in receiving your medications since our pharmacy has limited storage space.
