The following information is provided pursuant to the shellfish implementation plan adopted by the federal district court in United States v. Washington, 898 F. Supp. 1453 (W.D. Wash. 1995).

Date: December 14, 2020
Effective Date: December, 16 2020
Area: Gallagher Cove
Pick Up Location: **Arcadia Boat Ramp one half hour before the harvest**
BIDN: 281110 (DFW_GallagherSouth)
Growing Area: Totten Inlet
Dates/Times: **Open for harvesters on the list only:
Wednesday December 16, 2020 from 11:00 PM through 2:00 AM**
Gear/Technique: Hand held prying tool
Shellfish Type: 523- Pacific Oyster
Estimated Effort: 5 harvesters per harvest day.
Size Limit: There is no size limit for this harvest.
Justification: Available oyster resource.
Other Restrictions: Oyster Harvest will be in compliance with Squaxin Island Tribe Vibrio Plan. Product sold to dealer directly onsite. Time to Cooling requirement shall be the responsibility of the dealer.

Harvesters must be on the list in order to participate in this harvest.

Harvesters must provide a personal facemask to be worn at all times when on the barge and when interacting with the buyer and crew.

Harvester must maintain personal distance while on harvesting.

All harvest must be sold to the designated buyer.

In accordance with the Squaxin Island Shellfish Code, this regulation is hereby approved.
