

**Squaxin Island Tribe
Intertidal Shellfish Regulation
No. 2021-29**

The following information is provided pursuant to the shellfish implementation plan adopted by the federal district court in United States v. Washington, 898 F. Supp. 1453 (W.D. Wash. 1995).

Date: February 23, 2021

Effective Date: February 25, 2021

Growing Area: Totten Inlet

Pick Up: Arcadia ½ hour before the pick

BIDN: 281130 (DFW_Gallagher_N)

**Dates/Times: Open for harvesters on the list only:
Thursday February 25, 2021 from 9:30 PM through 12:30 AM**

Gear/Technique: Hand held prying tool

Shellfish Type: 523- Pacific Oyster

Estimated Effort: 10 harvesters per harvest day & assistants.

Bag Limit: No more than 1 tub may be harvested per harvester.

Size Limit: 2.5 inches or greater.

Justification: Available oyster resource.

Other Restrictions:

Harvesters must provide a personal facemask to be worn at all times when on the barge and when interacting with the buyer and crew.

- Oyster Harvest will be in compliance with Squaxin Island Tribe Vibrio Plan. Product sold to dealer directly onsite. Time to Cooling requirement shall be the responsibility of the dealer.
- Harvesters must be on the list in order to participate in this harvest. The list will be in possession of Salish Seafood Company Staff on site and in the Natural Resources Office.
- All harvest must be sold to the Salish Seafood Company.
- Harvesters may only pick within the marked areas on the beach.
- It is unlawful for tribal members or assistants to harvest shellfish while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. As per the Squaxin Island Tribal Code Section 7.04.160.

In accordance with the Squaxin Island Shellfish Code, this regulation is hereby approved.
