All that portion of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 19, Township 19N, Range 3W, Willamette Meridian, Mason County, Washington, particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Northwest corner of said NW<sup>1</sup>/4; thence S87°32'31"E along the North line thereof, 2,487.61 feet; thence S2°25'39"W, 1,011.79 feet; thence S2°12'38"E, 443.96 feet; thence S75°01'34"W, 1,246.85 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of the tract of land hereby described; thence S75°01'34"W, 268.56 feet; thence N8°51'44"W, 820.32 feet, more or less, to the Southeasterly right-of-way line of State Route 108; thence Northeasterly, along said Southeasterly right-of-way, 301.07 feet to a point N9°26'26"W of the point of beginning; thence S9°26'26"E, 944.60 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
