Island tribe of Indians is desirous of entering in a lease with Earl Smith of the Bayshore Uyster Co, Shelton Jachlagton, Mason County for the of tidelands Fronting on Lot, 16 Sec 22; all in Fownship 20 N.R. 2 7.M. For the purpose of planting only small seed oysters.

THEREAS..the Equaxin Island tribal council and Er Sarl Smith of the Bayshore Oyster Co.Agrees on a 1/00.20 per year, and after two years Mr Earl Smith is to pay to the Equaxin Island tribal council upon harvesting of oysters 15g per gallon of oysters

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED. by the Squarin Island tribal council, of the Squarin Island tribe that the Superintendent of the Western Jachington Agency or his duly authorized representative is hereby authorized and requested to prepare and approve the lease for the landsabove in accordance with the regulation of the Bureau of Indian Affairs governing such matters.
