

SQUAXIN TRIBE OF INDIANS
TRIBAL ENROLLEMENT RESOLUTION



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Whereas, the Squaxin Tribal Council, met on March 7, 1953, there being a quorum present, and in the course of the tribal business a motion was made seconded and unanimously adopted to the effect that the Secretary of the Squaxin Tribal Council, Florence Sigo, be instructed to file with the Western Washington Indian Agency, the said enrollment as the official enrollment of the SQUAXIN TRIBE OF INDIANS, which is the official list of enrolled members having SQUAXIN INDIAN ANCESTRY, that is to say, having Squaxin Blood;

Whereas, an official enrollment is necessary and proper for the purpose of tribal administration and for a certified TRIBAL CENSUS, for the Commissioner of Indian Affairs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED::::: that at the next tribal meeting to be held (90) thirty days from date, the said enrollment shall be proposed to the SQUAXIN TRIBAL COUNCIL assembled at the home of DON WHITENER, of Kamaltchie, Washington at 2:00 P.M. *ON APRIL 9/1953* and on that date the said enrollment shall be submitted to a vote of the Tribal Council, and if adopted it shall be filed by the Secretary with the Western Washington Indian Agency of Everett, Washington, to be finally closed for the year 1953, (90) ninety days from the date that said Official Enrollment is adopted by a majority vote of the said SQUAXIN INDIAN TRIBAL COUNCIL
