

RESOLUTION

At a Special Meeting of the Business Committee of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, State of Washington held in the City of Shelton, Washington on the 26th day of May 1955 at which time a quorum was present the following resolution was duly adopted:

Whereas, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of entering in a lease with the Davidson Logging Company of Vaughn, Washington for the use of Tidelands fronting on lot # 3 of Section 27; and lot # 4 of Section 26 all in Township 20 N., Range 2 W.N.M. For the purpose of logging and rafting of logs, and

Whereas, the Davidson Logging Company requests a lease be prepared providing for \$200 a year rental with a duration of one year.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: by the Business Committee of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Western Washington Agency, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized and requested to prepare and approve the lease for the above lands, in accordance with the regulations of the Bureau of Indian Affairs governing such matters.
