

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of the Squaxin Island Tribe is bonded in the amount of ~~(\$2,000.00)~~ and is charged with the responsibility of safekeeping and disbursing tribal funds as directed by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, there are funds on deposit in the United States Treasury in the account of the Squaxin Island Tribe for the use and benefit of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Council has formulated a budget estimate for fiscal years ~~1957~~ and ~~1958~~, and drawn up a Plan of Operations for the funds budgeted which are to be used for the benefit of the members of the Squaxin Island Tribal members;

IT IS HEREBY ~~THE~~ RESOLVED, and the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby requests that \$ 1483.49 be disbursed from the Squaxin Island Tribe Account in the United States Treasury to the Treasury of the Squaxin Island Tribe under an indefinite authorization for deposit in the local treasury and disbursement in accordance with the budget estimate submitted for fiscal year 1958.
