NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that application for lease on tidelands fronting on allotments sold at public bid sale will be approved at the sum of \$250.00 per sale parcel for a 12-month lease, and

BE IT FURTHER ENSOLVED, that the permittee or lessee	
shall designate one tideland area not to exceed 150 yards in length	
across which he shall transport his equipment and all the logs he	
removes.
