At a meeting of the tribal council of the Equation island Triba on the Teday of 1000, 1985, at which a quotum was present, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of 5 to 0

WWEDEAS, It is edvantageous to the purchaser of timber on the Squarin Island Indian Reservation to know that he will be sure of getting access to and from the Island across the tideland with his equipment and his purchased logs,

NOW, THE DEFORE, BE IT BESOLVED, that application for lease on tidelands Eventing on alletments sold at public bid sale will be approved at the sum of \$250.00 per cale percel for a 12month lexac, and

BE IT PUBLIER EESOLVED, that the permittee or lessee shall designate one tideland eren not to exceed 150 yards in length across which he shall transport his equipment and all the lose he removes.
