

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution, Bylaws and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of the tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe is a federally-recognized Indian Tribe possessing reserved powers, including the powers of self government;

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Squaxin Island Tribe Cultural Resources Department (CRD) worked closely with Cultural Resources Consultants, Inc. (CRC, Inc.) on a multi-year excavation and reinter of the Slocum and Oakland Cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, CRC, Inc. and CRD worked independently from one another on this joint project performed under one permit; and

WHEREAS, CRC, Inc. proved to be an exceptional company with high professional standards; and

WHEREAS, CRC, Inc. respected and abided by the tribes spiritual protocol at all times during the project; and

WHEREAS, the tribe appreciates and acknowledges without the support of CRC, Inc. numerous times during the project our CRD team would have faltered; and
