WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8,1965 ; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe is a federally-recognized Indian Tribe possessing reserved powers, including the powers of self-government; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and the Bylaws and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of the tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and bylaws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the powers and duties to encumber tribal lands, interests in lands, or other tribal assets.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs approval of the Mason County Public Works complete application for a survey incident to its request for a perpetual (permanent) Grant of Easement on tribal trust land known as the Kruger Property, parcels 31918-44-00050 and 31918-44-00051, located on tract number 157-T1193 as recorded with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (see attached legal description). The consent is for permission to survey and does not imply permission to construct, mobilizing or initiating construction activities on the subject property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FUTHER RESOVLED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council further authorizes the Chairman and/or the Director of Operations to perform all necessary transactions necessary to grant permission to survey the subject property, including obtaining, as necessary, federal approval, making non-substantive corrections to the documents attached if any, and executing any and all documents necessary to accomplish the same.
