

# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-**3%

## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution, Bylaws and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of the tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; **and** 

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of Education has announced the availability of funding through the American Indian Vocational Rehabilitation Services Grant Program for the fiscal years 2020-2024; **and** 

**WHEREAS,** for the past eleven years, the Nisqually Tribe and the Squaxin Island Tribe have successfully collaborated to operate an innovative Vocational Rehabilitation program that has served the Squaxin Island and Nisqually communities; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, the Nisqually Tribe has served as the lead applicant for the program in partnership with the Squaxin Island Tribe and the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency;

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NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Nisqually Indian Tribe to serve as lead applicant and prepare, submit, negotiate, execute, and administer with the U.S. Department of Education a grant proposal and agreement, and any amendments thereto. for the American Indian Vocational Rehabilitation Services Grant Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman, Tribal Administrator or Director of Operations to be the Tribe's signatory and representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project; and

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that these authorities shall be for the duration of the project.

### CERTIFICATION

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at the special meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 19 day of July 2019, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and O against with O abstentions.
