


SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE



RESOLUTION NO. 19-69

of the

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution, Bylaws and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of the tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe is a federally-recognized Indian Tribe possessing reserved powers, including the powers of self government;

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Emergency Management System assists in protecting Tribal Government and its members in the event of any emergencies and disasters, requires a written plan, to be published and supported by additional sub-plans; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe adopts our Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) in its entirety as the Squaxin Island Tribe's foundation document, Part A, which addresses the governmental operational structure during declared emergencies and disasters impacting tribal lands and assets.
