RESOLUTION # 70-1

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Council is desirous of allowing all tribal members to hunt on ~~property~~ owned by the tribe ~~on the Island, and~~

on Squaxin Island, and Bay and Accuaton Places.

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Council is desirous of allowing all tribal members to fish and dig for shell fish on beaches owned by the tribe, on the Island.

In Deseret Places on North Side

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that all tribal members of the Squaxin Island Tribe shall be allowed to hunt and to fish and dig shell fish on land and beaches owned by the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe.
