RESOLUTION NO. 00-70 OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of Tribal Members; **and**


WHEREAS, an offer has been made and accepted to purchase the Thovson property (legal description attached) by Island Enterprises, and for the tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the purchase of said property; **and**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the signatories on all escrow documents and/or documents pertaining to the purchase of said property, will be the Tribal Council Chairman, David Lopeman, and the Tribal Council Secretary, Pete Kruger
