WHEREAS, under the Constitution, By-Laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, an offer has been made and accepted to purchase the Moore property (legal description attached) by Island Enterprises, and for the tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the purchase of said property; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the signatories on all escrow documents and/or documents pertaining to the purchase of the said property, will be the Tribal Council Chairman, David Lopeman or the Tribal Council Secretary, Pete Kruger.

COMMENCING at the Southeast corner of said Section 18 ; thence North $86^{\circ} 06^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West, along the South line of said Section 18, 471.85 feet to the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Old Olympic Highway County Road No. 14010; thence North $42^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 07^{\prime \prime}$ West, along said right-of-way line, 138.18 feet; thence continue along said right-of-way line, North $43^{\circ} 27^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime}$ West, 135.03 feet, to a Norris bar and cap and to the point of beginning; thence South $53^{\circ} 00^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West, 137.13 feet to a Norris bar and cap; thence South $81^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime}$ West, 46.15 feet to a Norris bar and cap; thence continue South $81^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime}$ West, 11.94 feet, more or less, to the centerline of Little Skookum Creek; thence Northerly, along said creek, 60 feet, more or less, to the right-of-way line of State Highway 101 and being opposite of Road Station $430+00$; thence Eastenly or Westerly, along said right-of-way line, to a point opposite Highway Engineer's Station (hereinafter referred to as HES) S-EW 3+37.32 on the S-EW line survey of State Route 101, State Route 108 interchange and 106.55 feet Southeasterly therefrom; thence Northerly, to a point opposite HES S-EW 3+73.57 and 84.77 feet Southeasterly therefrom; thence Northerly to a point opposite HES S-EW 4+50.79 and 54,28 feet Southeasterly therefrom: thence Northeasterly to a point opposite HES S-EW $5+02.61$ and 56.55 feet Southeasterly therefrom, to the Southerly right-of-way line of Old Olympic Highway County Road No. 14010 ; thence Southeasterly, along said right-of-way line, 192 feet. more or less, to the point of beginning.

TOGETHERWITH and subject to a perpetual nonexclusive easement for ingress and egress over the following described tract;

COMMENCING at the Southeast corner of said Section 18 ; thence North $86^{\circ} 06^{\prime} 30^{\circ}$ West, along the South line of said Section $18,471.85$ feet to the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Old Olympic Highway County Road No. 14010 ; thence North $42^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 07^{\prime \prime}$ West, along said right-of-way line, 138.18 feet; thence continue along said right-of-way line, North $43^{\circ} 27^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime}$ West, 135.03 feet to a Norris bar and cap and to the point of beginning; thence South $53^{\circ} 00^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West, 137.13 feet to a Norris bar and cap; thence North $41^{\circ} 38^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime}$ East, 136.76 feet to the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Old Olympic Highway County Road No. 14010; thence South $43^{\circ} 27^{\prime} 22^{\prime \prime}$ East, 27.14 Feet to the point of beginning.
