



## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-19**

**SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution, Bylaws and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of the tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; **and**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to obtain title insurance to convey fee land into trust land, and title insurance companies require authorized signers to be designated by the Tribal Council; **and**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** declares that David Lopeman, Chairman and Susan McFarlane former Secretary respectively of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council were empowered to sign property deeds for the Squaxin Island Tribe for the years of 1999 and 2000, and the **Squaxin Island Tribal Council** hereby ratifies that Statutory Warranty Deed dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 2000, recorded under Auditor's File Numbers: 1711260, 1711261, 1711262, by and between the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, as Grantor, and United States of America in Trust for the Squaxin Island Tribe, as Grantee, said deeds properly signed and executed by David Lopeman, Chairman, and Susan McFarlane, former Secretary.

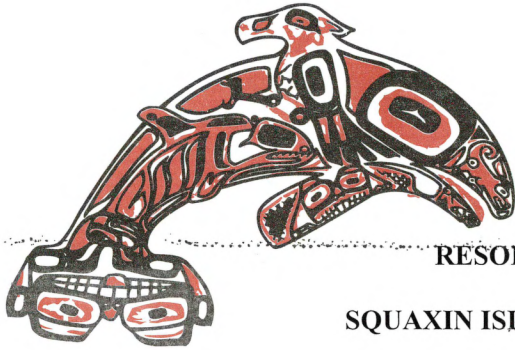
**CERTIFICATION**
