**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution, By-Laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of tribal members, **and**


**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to full fill their duty of protecting the heath, security, education, and general welfare  
Of the tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; **and**

**WHEREAS**, The Squaxin Island Tribe supported the formation of the American Indian Health Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby designate Steve Sigo of the Council as the delegate and the Squaxin Island Health Director as the alternate to sit on the Washington State American Indian Health Commission.
