

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe by resolution dated September 30, 1967 authorized the Squaxin Island Tribal Council to enter into leases on tribal lands on behalf of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Don Whitener has applied for a lease on tribal lands described as:

Tracts immediately adjacent to and fronting upon the following described lands:

59 chains within the northerly portion of Lot 1 sec. 15, T. 20 N., R. 2 W., Willamette Meridian, Mason County, Washington, within extended north and south side property lines;

at an annual rental of \$147.50 for a term of five years beginning on February 1, 1967, and twenty 20 of

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council consents to the granting of said lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute said lease.
