


RESOLUTION
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Western Washington Agency is planning for a sale of timber on the Isaac allotment, No. 3, on the Squaxin Island Reservation as requested by the Indian owners of said allotment, and

WHEREAS, the purchaser of the timber will have to move the logs and forest products produced over tidelands belonging to the Squaxin Island Tribe,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council that it authorizes the Purchaser of the timber on the Isaac allotment to raft and transport the logs and forest products produced on and over tribal tidelands abutting the Isaac allotment, for a fee of \$ 175 per 1,000 board feet Decimal C Log Scale, and that the Council authorize and request the Superintendent of the Western Washington Agency to grant a revocable permit for a right of way to such purchaser for a term which shall be for the duration of the timber sale contract covering the sale of timber on the Isaac allotment, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council be authorized to sign any documents in connection with this transaction on behalf of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council.
