SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, its members, its lands, its enterprises and its agencies by authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution, Bylaws, and inherent sovereignty of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and with protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources and rights of the Tribe; **and**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the creation of ordinances and resolutions in order to fulfill their duty of protecting the health, security, education, and general welfare of tribal members, and of protecting and managing the lands and treaty resources of the Tribe; **and**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a consortium, member of the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency (SPIPA), that manages contracts and services, especially in the areas of health and social services; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council desires to appoint the delegates by position rather than by name; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is currently represented by a Primary Delegate and an Alternate Delegate appointed to the SPIPA Board by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby reappoints the Tu'Ha'Buts Learning Center Director as the Primary Delegate the Deputy Executive Director as the Alternate Delegate to the SPIPA Board of Directors as voting representatives of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and
