WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe in accordance with its Constitution and Bylaws, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, In accordance with Article III, Section 1.(f) of the approved Constitution and Bylaws, the Tribal Council is authorized to administer the funds under the control of the Tribe and to make available funds for Tribal purposes in accordance with an approved Tribal budget; and,

TRIBAL OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council approved a Tribal budget for Fiscal Year 1971 in the total amount of \$2150.00 in a special meeting held at Kamilche, Washington on 18th of July, 1970; and,

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Treasurer is a bonded Tribal official, bonded to the Tribe and is authorized to receipt for and to disburse funds in the name of the Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED By the Squaxin Island Tribal Council that it hereby approves the following budget for Fiscal Year 1971 and requests the Superintendent of the Western Washington Agency to approve the Fiscal Year 1971 budget shown below.
