WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe is also desirous of a lesser lease payment to members of the tribe only than to non-Indians, and

WHEREAS, this lesser payment to members of the tribe is a legitimate request based on the fact that the lands (tide lands) to be leased belong to the Tribe, and we are in fact contributing to the Tribal Treasury fund.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, That the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians, by its recognized governing <sup>body</sup> ~~body~~, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council, hereby agrees to the foregoing conditions of leasing tide lands on Squaxin Island.
