At the General Council Meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribe held near Kamilche on September 24, 1967, applications for adoption in the Tribe made by Ula B. Jackson and Roy Edward Dailey were considered.


It was the understanding of the membership that both applicants are of 1/8 or more Indian blood.

Both applicants are living in the Squaxin Island community and have been active in it.

Therefore, it was resolved by the General Council that the names of Ula B. Jackson and Roy Edward Dailey be submitted to the Secretary of the Interior to be approved as adopted members of the Squaxin Island Tribe.

CERTIFICATION

I certify that the above resolution was approved at a General Council meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribe held on September 24, 1967, and that the vote on the adoption of Ula B. Jackson, which was taken by secret ballot, was 22 for and 1 against, and the vote on the adoption of Roy Edward Dailey, also taken by secret ballot, was 18 for and 4 against.
