

RESOLUTION OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal council is the governing body of the tribe;

WHEREAS, the leasing of tidelands is the tribe's only means of income;

WHEREAS, the tribe wishes for all persons who desire shellfish from Squaxin Island to sell commercially to apply for and to obtain a lease.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that all persons who wish, for commercial use to obtain shellfish from Squaxin Island, shall be required to apply for and to receive a lease from the Squaxin Island Tribal Council.

This applies to the members of the Squaxin island Tribe as well as the non-members.
