WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe by resolution dated September 30, 1962, authorized the Squaxin Island Tribal Council to enter into leases on tribal lands on behalf of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Florence Sigo has applied for a lease on tribal lands described as:

Tidelands immediately adjacent to and fronting upon the following described lands: That portion of Lot 5 lying southerly of the normal north 1/16 line, and Lot 4, sec. 34, T. 20 N., R. 2 W., and that portion of Lot 1, sec. 35, T. 20 N., R. 2 W., lying northerly of the summer campsite lots; within extended north and south side property lines, containing 20 lineal chains, more or less, and subject to two access leases to the Tacoma Narrows Bridge Company, Willamette Meridian, Mason County, Washington,

at an annual rental of \$50.00 for a term of ten (10) years beginning on October 16, 1963,

WHEREAS, the applicant is a member of this Tribe, we hereby waive any bonding requirements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council consents to the granting of said lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute said lease.
