RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council passed Ordinance #1 on October 5, 1967 and was approved on October 27, 1967,

WHEREAS, the Resolution set an opening date of fishing on October 16, 1967 and a closing date on November 17, 1967

WHEREAS, the closure date included in Ordinance #1 does not adequately cover the migration period for chum salmon, and an extension of the season <sup>through</sup> to December 1, 1967 would be more appropriate and fair to tribal members,

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has reported that the additional fishing time would not adversely affect chum salmon runs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the closing date on the fishing season as stated in Ordinance #1 be amended from November 17, 1967 to read

December 2 at 6AM, 1967

This Resolution was duly passed at a Special Meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council by a vote of 3 for and 0 against.
