RESOLUTION

of the

Squaxin Island Tribe

Attn: Proposal to Res
Proposed

Whereas, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the duly authorized governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and,

whereas, the major concern of the Squaxin Island Tribe is the retention of the Island as a Tribal land base, and,

whereas, the Tribe is utilizing a \$5700 Planning Grant to retain consultants to plan for the future of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and,

whereas, the Tribe is fully cognizant that, any implementation of plans will depend on the Tribes ability to coordinate resources available for development, and,

whereas, the Tribe needs to train an individual member for this task, and,

whereas, the Tribe submits the proposal enclosed for the purpose of developing leadership.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribe goes on record as requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist in the manner prescribed in the enclosed proposal.

CERTIFICATION
