

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe by resolution dated September 30, 1962, authorized the Squaxin Island Tribal Council to enter into leases on tribal tidelands on behalf of the tribe, and

WHEREAS, Bessie Trick has applied for a lease on tribal tidelands fronting Government Lot 4, sec. 34, Government Lots 1, 2 and 3, sec. 35, T. 20 N., R. 2 W., Willamette Meridian, Mason County, Washington, containing 105 lineal chains, more or less, at an annual rental of \$367.50 for a five year term beginning December 1, 1962,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council consents to the granting of said lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute said lease.
