> Pursuant to your request for technical assistance, please find enclosed two proposed Tribal Acts. These two proposed Acts, as we have already discussed, are for the Squaxin Island Tribe's consideration and represent a rough draft which can serve as working documents to be revised, reworked, refined and polished by the Squaxin Tribe until it is satisfactory.

The purpose of one proposed Act is to set up a tribal licensing authority which can allow the tribe to license Indian enterprises and to create and license corporate entities.

The purpose of the other proposed Act is to suggest a way that the Squaxin Island Tribe might create a corporate entity to be known as The Squaxin Island Tribe Aquaculture Enterprise, which would have the authority and responsibility to develop the tribe's aquaculture industry.

If you have any questions, I will be in your area March 3, 1971 and I will be happy to answer questions concerning the two proposed Acts.

Here are the petitions and resolution you asked for. I am enclosing several copies of the resolution as you will need to send a copy to several individuals. It would be wise for the Council to notify BIA in Everett of your intentions concerning PL 280 so that they can prepare a recommendation to the Governor on your retrocession.

The steps I recommend in this procedure are again:

- Discussion and explanation among tribal members; 1)
- Petition by or vote of the General Council requesting 2) the Tribal Council to act;
- 3) Resolution by the Tribal Council;
- Tribal Council requests the BIA to recommend retrocession 4) to the Governor:
- Submission of Resolution to Governor, State and Local 5) Legislative Representatives.

I am also sending along the letter of introduction to the matter used by the Muckleshoot Tribe. You may want to use it as a model.
