WHEREAS, the Squarin Ts Tribe has indicated an interest to assume greater and more active participation in reservation programs by providing educational activities for younger Tribal members and essential products and services for needed programs on the reservation; and

WHEREAS, this can be accomplished by contracting with the Federal Government through the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the authority contained in the Act of June 25, 1910 (25 USC 47); and

Whereas, the basic document for contracting will be by Purchase order, providing for payments on a "Job" basis with one invoice submitted at the termination of the program to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for reimbursement of Tunds expended under the purchase order; and

WHEREAS, funds will be used exactly for the purpose for which they were intended, as outlined in the approved program; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs will provide, when requested, technical assistence to the tribes in recruiting and screening applicants, idetermining qualifications. and training the applicants in the various shills; and

WHEREAS the Tribe will participate in the programs to their ability insofar as they are able, in furnishing personnel, materials, insurance, available funds and adequate facilities for work space and activities; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Is Tribal Counse | designates Florence Sign (Tribal Governing Body)
Chairman and Virgina Sign Ado to serve as

Tribal representatives fullyauthorized to approve and sign all documents for the effective completion, execution, and management of such contract.
