WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island tribe is desirous of having available outside resources made available for the use of the tribe, and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Dewey Sigo, in the past has proven his ability to seek out and discover resources which were not previously known to be available to the tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith select and appoint Mr. Dewey Sigo to be the tribe's Tribal Expediter Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Expediter will be funded by Federal Funds through STOWW at no expense to the tribe.
