WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe is desirous of having S.T.O.W.W., Inc. follow-up and carry through a course of action to help the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe with its pollution problem, and,

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe can't use or sell their shellfish (oysters, Clams) adjoining the Washington State Park boat moorage facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith request the assistance of S.T.O.W.W., Inc. To follow-up and carry through a course of action necessary to help the Squaxin Island Tribe solve the problem of contamination and pollution of Squaxin Island shellfish growing areas caused by the over board disposal of human waste from the public use of the State Park boat moorage facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is authorized to turn over to STOWW, Inc. copies of tribal documents and correspondence which document and define the problem of contamination and pollution of the Squaxin Island shellfish growing areas.
