WHEREAS, the rental for this lease no. 6191 on Squaxin Island tidelands will be \$400.00 a year starting October 1, 1971, through September 3, 1972,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council are desirous of entering into this lease agreement with Mr. Jameson M. Peters, October 1, 1971 through September 30, 1972, on a yearly basis for a period of five (5) years, or as long as Mr. Peters and/or the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wishes to continue this lease, No. 6191 during the next five (5) years,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Florence Sigo, Chairman and Calvin J. Peters, Secretary of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority to negotiate a lease with the leasees Jameson M. Peters.

RESOLUTION

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section (b) of the Constitution and ByLaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, approved July 8, 1965, empowers the Tribal Council to enter into leases on tribal lands on behalf of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Jameson and Calvin Peters ^{have} ~~has~~ applied for a lease on tribal lands described as:

Tidelands of second class owned by Squaxin Island Tribe situated in front of and adjacent to or abutting upon Lots 6 & 7, Sec. 22, T. 20 N., R. 2 W., Willamette Meridian, Mason County, Washington with frontage of 40 lineal chains, more or less.

at an annual rental of \$400.00 for a term of five years beginning on October 1, 1971, and
