WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe is desirous of having a Tribal Manager and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has need for this person to help operate and help find funds for the Squaxin Island aquaculture project, land aquisition, land development and housing project, and other projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith request the assistance of the BIA to follow up and carry through a course of action necessary to help the Squaxin Island Tribe to acquire the funds for paying a Tribal Manager.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians have an immediate need for a Tribal Manager who will work under the immediate supervision of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council and with the Tribal Coordinator to help carry on with the advancement of the Squaxin Island aquaculture project and land development program.
