WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe is desirous of having the United States Department of the Interior, Geological Survey (Water Resources Division) carry through a course of action to drill test wells of Squaxin Island, for the Squaxin Island Indians, and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of having the B.I.A. follow up and carry through a course of action to help the Squaxin Island Tribe with its fund, and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe can use these test wells to further advance the Squaxin Island Aquaculture Project, as well as the over all Squaxin Island Land Developmental Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith request the assistance of the B.I.A. to follow up and carry through a course of action necessary to help the Squaxin Island Tribe to acquire the funds to complete the test wells.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians have an immediate need for these test wells, to help carry on with the advancement of the Squaxin Island Agriculture Project and Land Development Program scheduled to begin in the spring of 1972.
