WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing body, of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe is desirous of having the Bureau of Indian Affairs carry through a course of action to help the Squaxin Island Indians obtain the Olympia Reserve Fleet MARAD for mainland base for their aquaculture program on Squaxin Island, when it comes up for surplus in the early part of 1972 and freeze this property for the Squaxin Island Tribe.

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe can use this property for a Squaxin Island project office base, as well as a processing plant for the Fisheries, oyster, and clam programs, a fish laboratory and oyster hatchery, a motor training and repair shop, Indian crafts and tourist center, an archive center for Indian people, as well as a meeting hall for their tribe, as well as other Indian Tribes in conjunction with the Squaxin Island comprehensive 10-year Land Development Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to follow up and carry through a course of action necessary to help the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe obtain the Olympia Reserve Fleet MARAD Property in Olympia when it becomes surplus in the early part of 1972.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe has the support vote to them by the Governor's Indian Advisory Committee and the S.F.O.W.W. tribal members at their last meeting in January, 1972, as well as the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Manager of the Squaxin Island Tribe, Calvin J. Peters, has the authority to work with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in any way that will be helpful in obtaining the Olympia Reserve Fleet MARAD for the Tribe.
