WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe and,

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of having the Bureau of Indian Affairs carry through a course of action to Lease or obtain a use permit from the proper people or Federal Government that are responsible for the Olympia MARAD property, for the Squaxin Island Tribe. Until such time this property is turned over to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and,

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribe realizes this property will not be come available until sometime after July 1, 1972, but have need for it as soon as possible to carry on the planning program of the Squaxin Island Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council herewith request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to follow-up a course of action necessary to help the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe to obtain a lease or a use permit for the Olympia Reserve Fleet MARAD property in Olympia as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Manager of the Squaxin Island Tribe, Calvin J. Peters has the authority to work with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in any way that will be helpful in obtaining the Olympia Reserve Fleet MARAD property for the Tribe.
