WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is aware of the need of new homes and home improvement program for our Tribal members and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of having the Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington take a course of action and negotiate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Home Improvement Program, and Indian Health Services funds to construct new homes and develop a home improvement program for the Squaxin Island Indians and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council believe it to be progressive action in the best interest of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe to initiate a new home and a Home Improvement Program as soon as possible for the Squaxin Island Tribal members;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council designate Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington to take a course of action and negotiate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Home Improvement Program, and Indian Health Services to construct new homes and develop a home improvement program for the Squaxin Island Tribe,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Manager of the Squaxin Island Tribe, Calvin J. Peters has the authority to work with the Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington in any way that will be helpful in negotiating with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Home Improvement Program and Indian Health Services for the Tribe.
