WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of leasing tidelands to Edward W. Tobin, for the purpose of raising oysters for commercial use, and use for private privilege and,

WHEREAS, the rental for this lease No. <u>6 4 2 3 on Squaxin Island</u>
tidelands will be \$300.00 a year starting <u>October 1, 1972</u> through
<u>September 30, 1977</u>,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council are desirous of entering into this lease agreement with <u>Edward W. Tobin</u>,

October 1, 1972 through <u>September 30, 1977</u> on a yearly basis for a period of <u>five</u> years, or as long as <u>Edward W. Tobin</u> and/or the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wishes to continue this lease, No. <u>6423</u> during the next <u>five</u> years,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Florence Sigo, Chairman and Calvin J. Peters, Secretary of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority to negotiate a lease with the leasee <u>Edward W. Tobin</u>.
