WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe having borrowed \$2,765.49 from the Seattle First National Bank, Secoma Branch, 33370 Pacific Highway South, Federal Way, Washington with an interest in the amount of \$58.58, the payment in full will be \$2,824.07 and,


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wants to pay this amount, \$2,824.07 to close out the loan, out of the Tribes Jobs Now Program funds.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these funds are to be taken from the Jobs Now Program, our number one priority will be to reimburse the Jobs Now Program with the funds received from the sales of oysters.
