WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is supporting S.T.O.W.W. in forming such a program and soliciting applications to trainees in S.T.O.W.W. communities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council do request S.T.O.W.W. to follow through on a course of action to seek funds, to start a small equipment shop from whatever funding sources that may be available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council gives permission to S.T.O.W.W. to come to our area to solicit applications from our Tribal members who are interested in pursuing this type of training.
