"THE AUDITING OF THE TRIBES' BOOKS"

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe and,

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribe is in need of having their tribal council treasury books audited, as in the past, it has never been done and,


WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of having the Bureau of Indian Affairs office take a course of action, to appoint an auditor and/or to seek funds for the Tribe to hire their own auditor, to audit the Tribal Council's treasury books.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs office take a course of action to help the Squaxin Island Tribe get an auditor to audit the Tribal Council's treasury books, by whatever means necessary.
