WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe and,

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribe is aware of the fact that Mr. William Veeder's travel has been frozen and that he is not allowed to attend area meetings on Water Rights and,

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribe as a member of the Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington are aware of a meeting being called by S.T.O.W.W. on October 19-20, 1973, on Water Rights at which time Mr. William Veeder has been invited to attend with nineteen (19) Tribal Chairmen to establish Water Rights and/or any necessary ordinances on Indian Treaty Rights.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe is requesting the Members of Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians to write letters of support in getting Mr. Veeder's release from Washington, D.C. to make him available to attend this meeting at the S.T.O.W.W. office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been advised by S.T.O.W.W. Executive Director, Roy S. George Sr., that any and all Tribes interested in attending this meeting at the S.T.O.W.W. office, 33324 Pacific Highway South, Federal Way, Washington 98002, on October 19-20, 1973, are welcome.
