HOUSING AUTHORIZATION

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe, and;

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is aware of the need of new homes and home improvement for the Squaxin Island Indian people, and;

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribe through its Housing Authority is desirous of sponsoring a Low Rental Housing Development Program, with the assistance of Farmers Home Administration (FHA), and;

WHEREAS the proposed program will consist of twelve (12) contracted housing units.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council as the Sponsoring agent does hereby promulgate to the promotion and advancement of the Squaxin Island Low Rental Housing program, with financial assistance through Farmers Home Administration.


