WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and,

WHEREAS a ground-water resource investigation for the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation has been proposed by the United States Geological Survey Department in conjunction with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe; and.

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Water Resource Investigation Project was initiated in fiscal year 1974; and

WHEREAS financial assistance in the amount of thirty-four thousand (\$34,000.00) has been allocated by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and,

WHEREAS seventeen thousand five hundred (\$17,500.00) of this thirty-four thousand (\$34,000.00) is to be set aside for fiscal year 1975 and the remaining seventeen thousand five hundred (\$17,500.00) has been contracted and will be used as of this date, June 26, 1974; and,

WHEREAS the Squaxin Island Tribal Council will hereby continue to comply with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, by submitting quarterly progress reports, in the agreement originally written up in Resolution 7409, to work towards the completion of the following phases of work on the Project:

- (a) General water resource exploration of Island, location of springs, nature of vegetation, location of swamps and wet areas, and other indications of factors that affect ground water occurrence.
- (b) Mark, survey and flag the access routes of each well.
- (c) Locational description of Well #2, Allotment #8, in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 20 north, Range 2 west; this will be drilled within the 1.84 acre boundary of tribal owned land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, on this date of June 25, 1974, contract Dewey E. Sigo, Squaxin Island Tribal Member, as Tribal Coordinator between the Tribal Business Manager and the United States Geological Survey and all involved with the Water Wells Project to its completion. Payment of each phase will be made upon the submission of an invoice of work.
