WHEREAS, an Indian Fishing Commission has been formed and it is necessary to appoint a commissioner and delegate and alternate for the commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council submits the Tribal Council Secretary and Tribal Business Manager, Calvin J. Peters as our nominee for the Fish Commission.

Myrtle Penn and Ed Tobin enrolled members of the Squaxin Island Tribe in good stand as our at large members, to the Medicine Creek Treaty Fishery Council.
