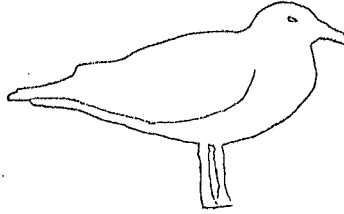

RESOLUTION NO. 75-25 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for the Economic Development of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the Comprehensive Plan for the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation states the advisability of conducting a study to determine the economic and biological feasibility for rearing Manila Clams (*Venerupis japonica*) on intertidal lands of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize Business Manager, Calvin J. Peters, to take a course of action to implement a proposal for a determination of the economic and biological feasibility for rearing Manila Clams (*Venerupis japonica*).

CERTIFICATION


