

RESOLUTION NO. 75-32 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is aware of the many services provided the Tribes of the Employment Assistance Division of the WWA -BIA, Everett and Hoquiam, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been informed that there are plans to eliminate two positions from this Division and that the budget is set to be decreased \$140,000 for Employment Assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council Tribal Council soes not feel Employment Assistance will be able to function properly or perform adequatly if these plans are carried out.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does strongly urge that the plans to eliminate two Employment Assistance positions and decrease by \$140,000 their Employment Assistance budget, be stopped.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council suggests that if positions and budgets need to be cut, these cuts be taken at the Portland Area Office rather than jeoparadize the efficiency of the Agency and field offices.

RESOLUTION NO. 75-32 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as ap proved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of taking a course of action to preserve and protect the natural resources of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, one of the steps taken to preserve and protect those interests is the prohibiting of gasoline driven vehicles of any sort within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation without specific permission of the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Edward Tobin has approached the Squaxin Island Tribal Council for permission to take onto his property within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation a gas driven vehicle for the purpose of logging, and

WHEREAS, the logging to be performed on his property will be in limited amount, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tobin will find it necessary to cross tribally owned and operated beaches for the removal of his logs,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby permit Mr. Edward Tobin Squaxin Island Tribal Member to take onto his property a gas driven vehicle of necessary size to perform logging duties,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in order to conduct and practice sound conservation methods this vehicle shall be equipped with rubber tires and the logging, as agreed upon by Mr. Tobin, shall be of a limited nature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a tax of \$1.00 per thousand foot as negotiated between the Tribal Council and Mr. Tobin. shall be collected for the transport of his timber ofer Tribal tidelands and that the total amount of this tax shall be determined upon presentation of his timber sales receipts to the Council which should be made no longer than 2 weeks following the sale of the timber.

CERTIFICATION

The Foregoing Resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on March 31, 1975, at which time a quorum of Council Members were present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and 0 against.
